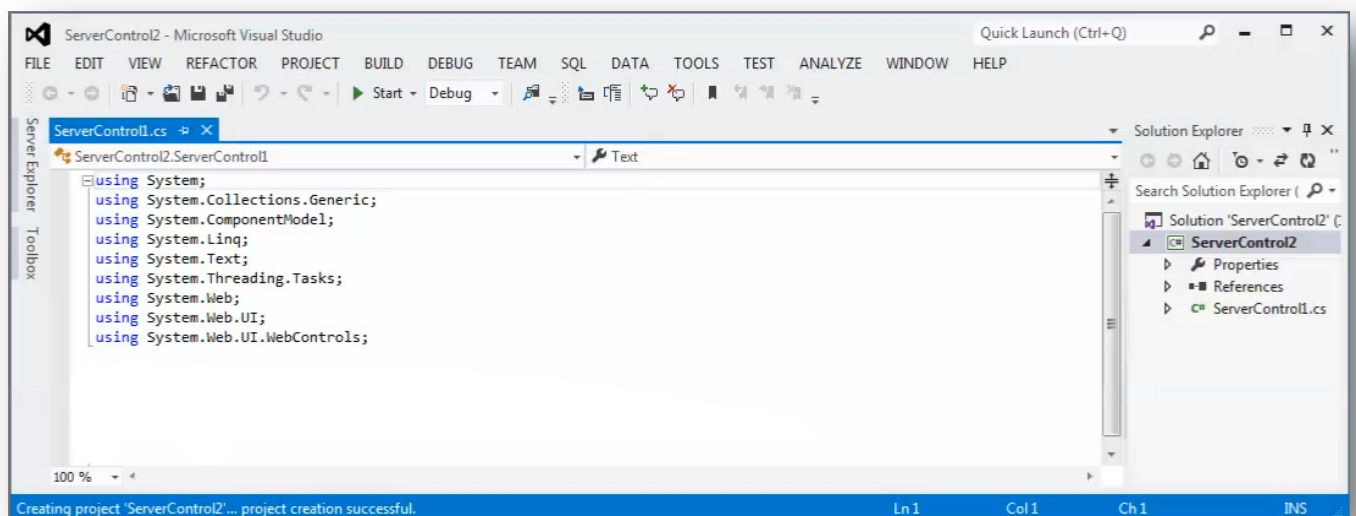

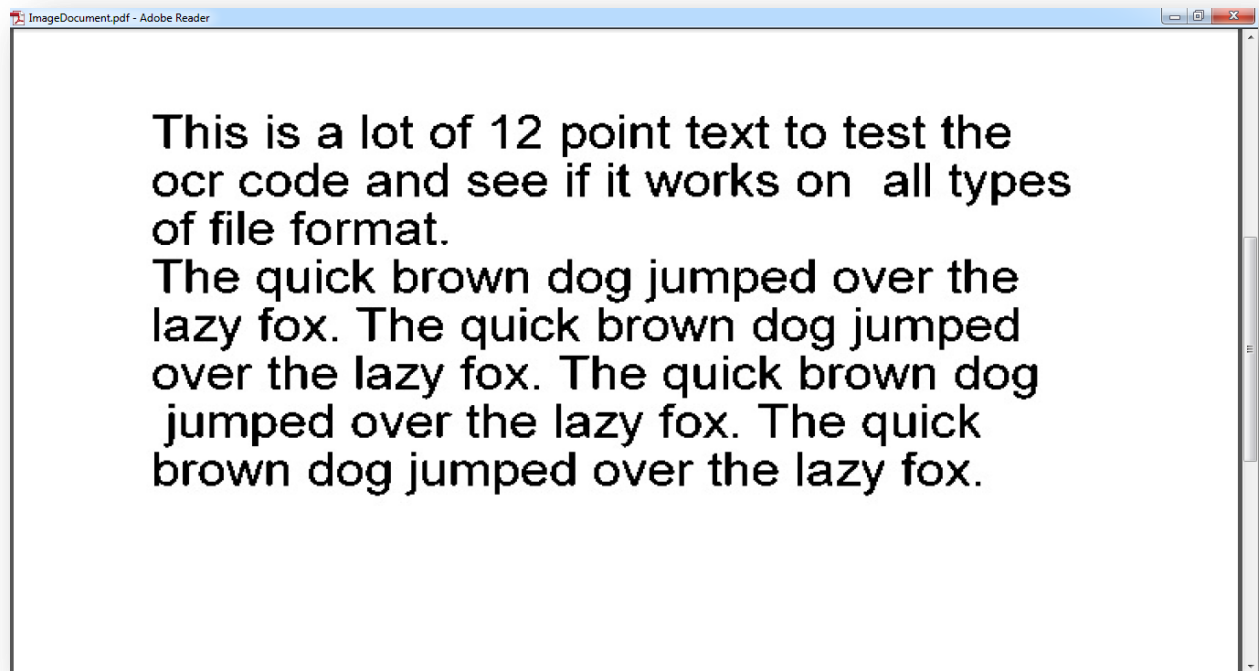

OCR Support

Essential PDF uses the Tesseract OCR engine to convert unsearchable text found within images in PDF documents to searchable text. The converted PDF document looks identical to the original but adds the extra capability to search, select, and copy text from images.

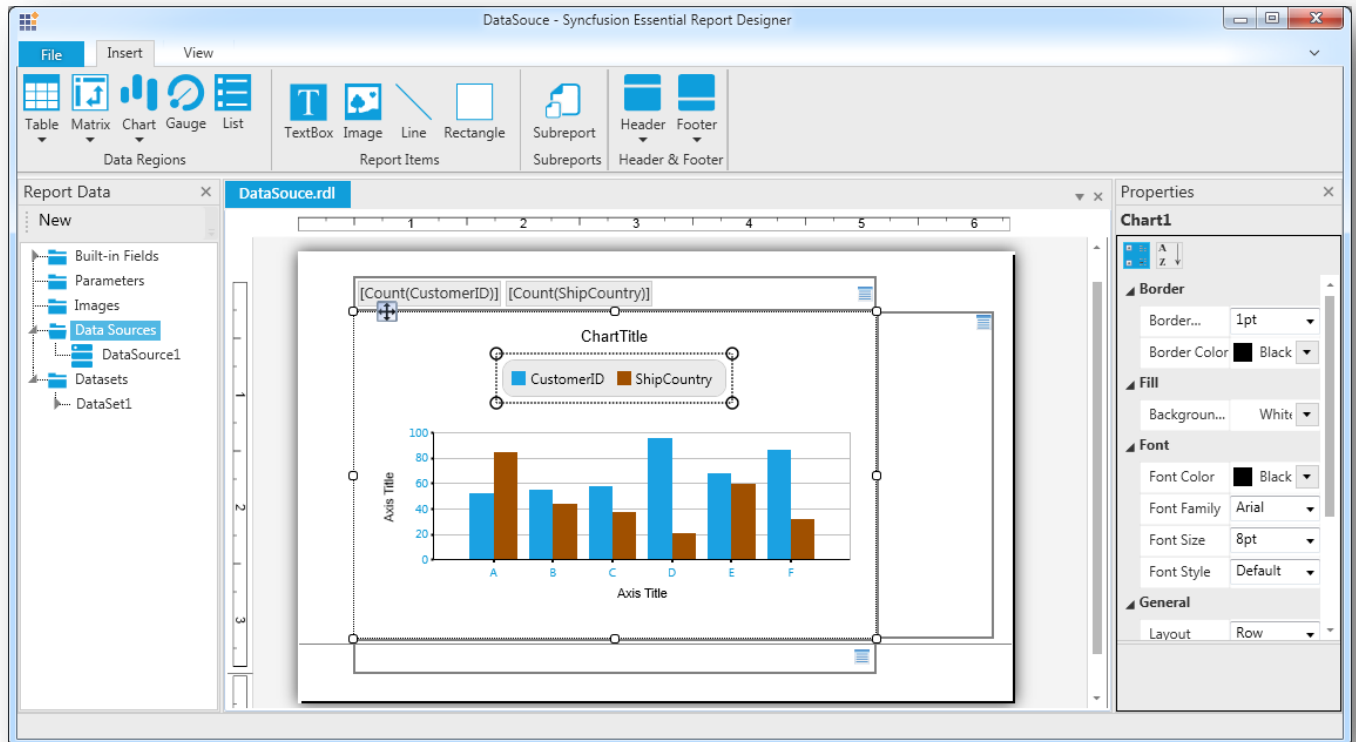
Enhanced Image Handling

Improved Usability

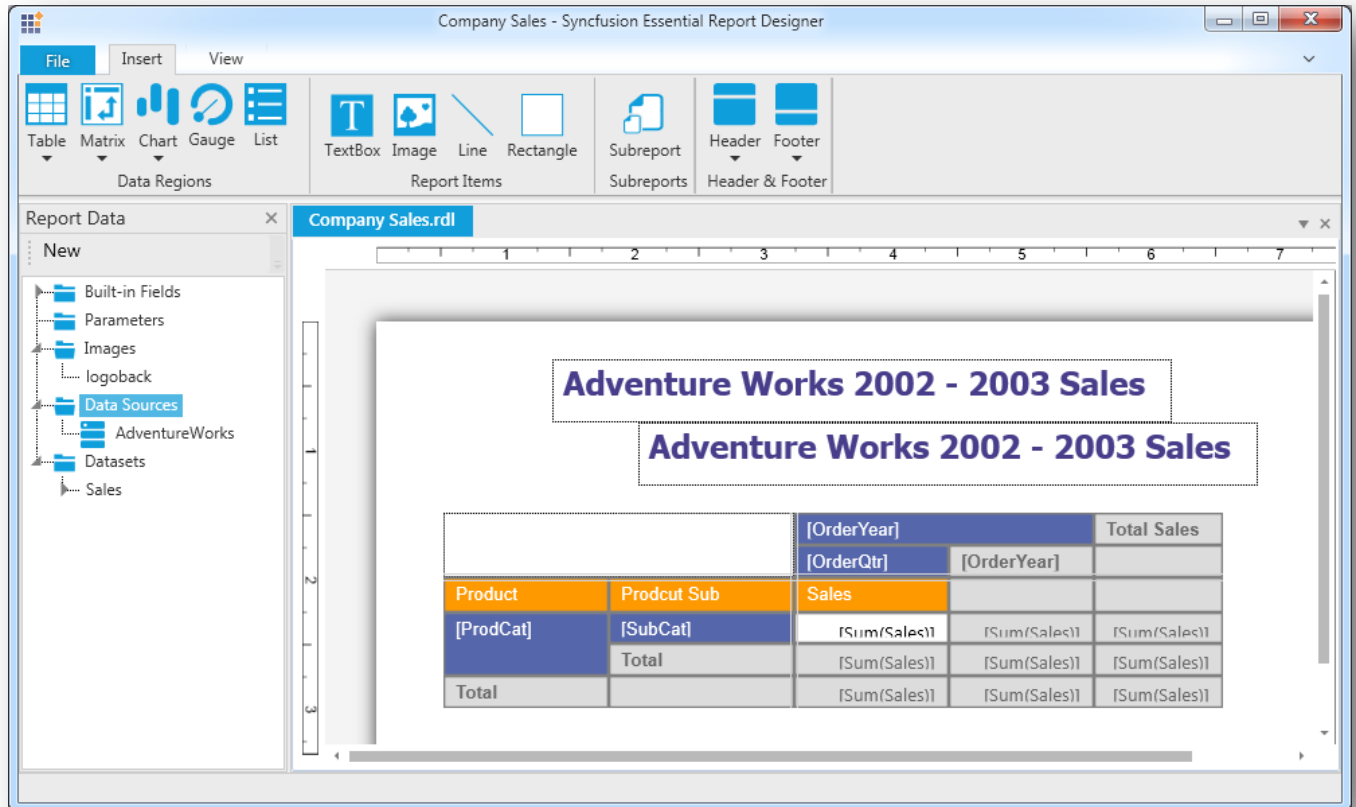
The usability of the Report Designer has been greatly improved. Significant changes include the ability to interactively modify properties of chart elements such as legends, series, and titles through the designer.

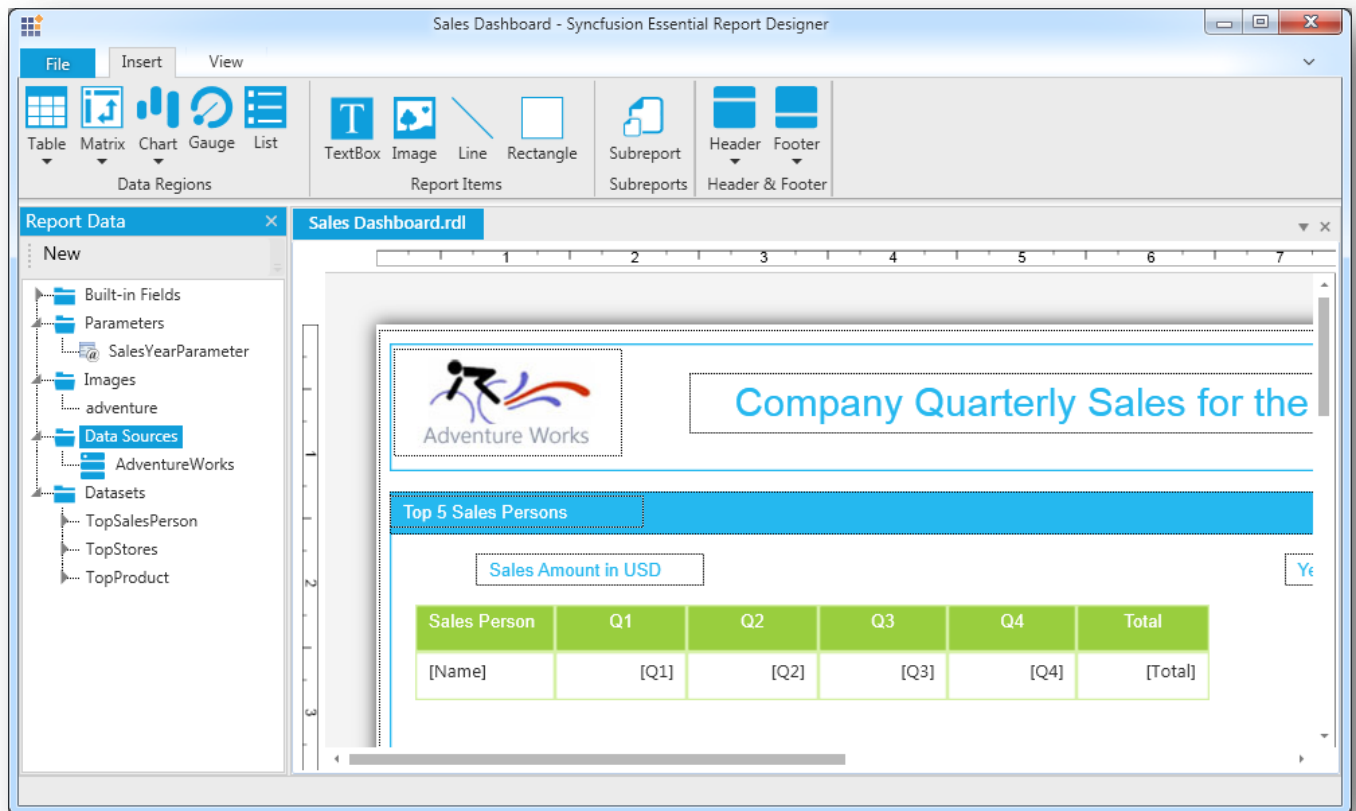

Creating RDL Format Reports

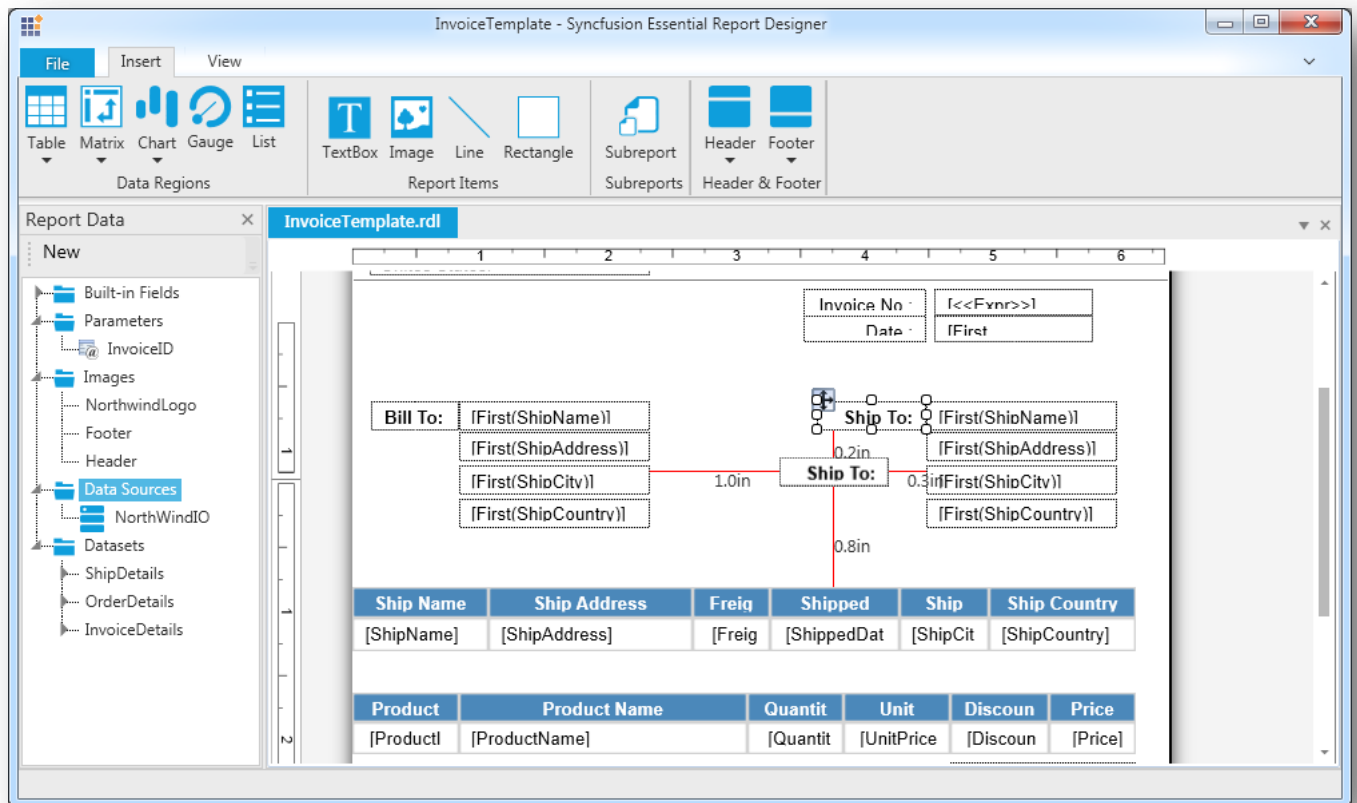
Users can create and modify Microsoft RDL format (2008 or 2008 R2) reports in the Report Designer, providing a long-term solution for reporting formats.

Item Size and Placement

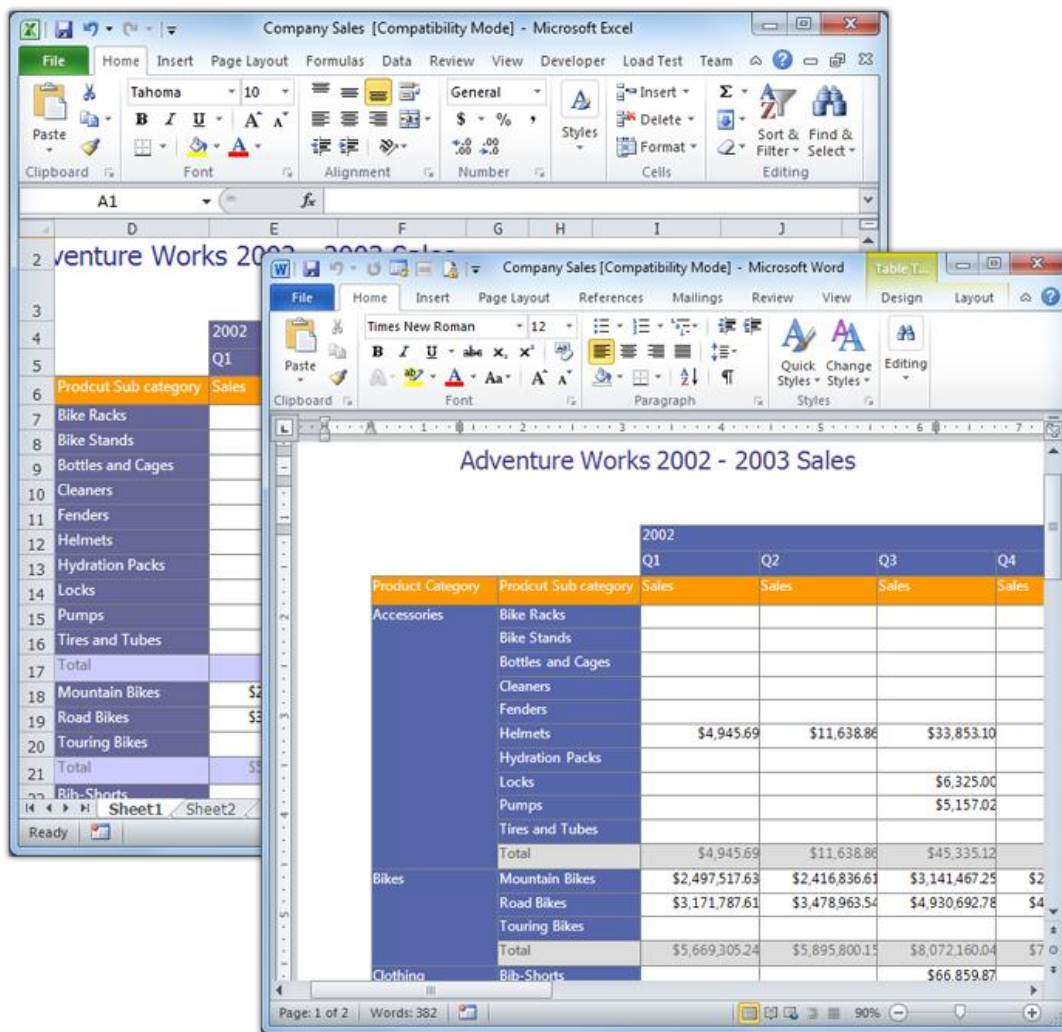

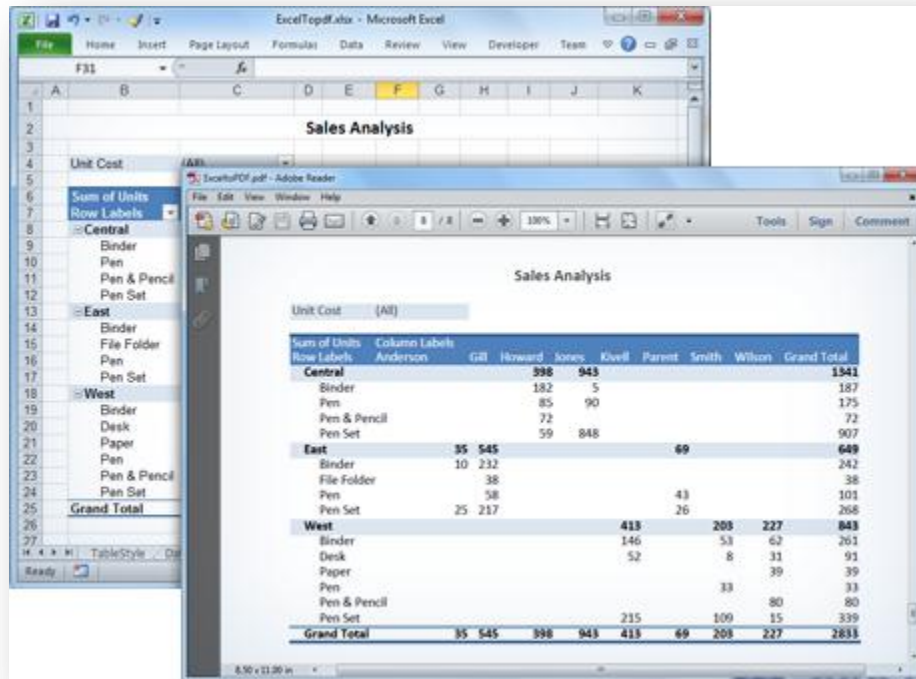


RDL Reports Exported to Excel and Word

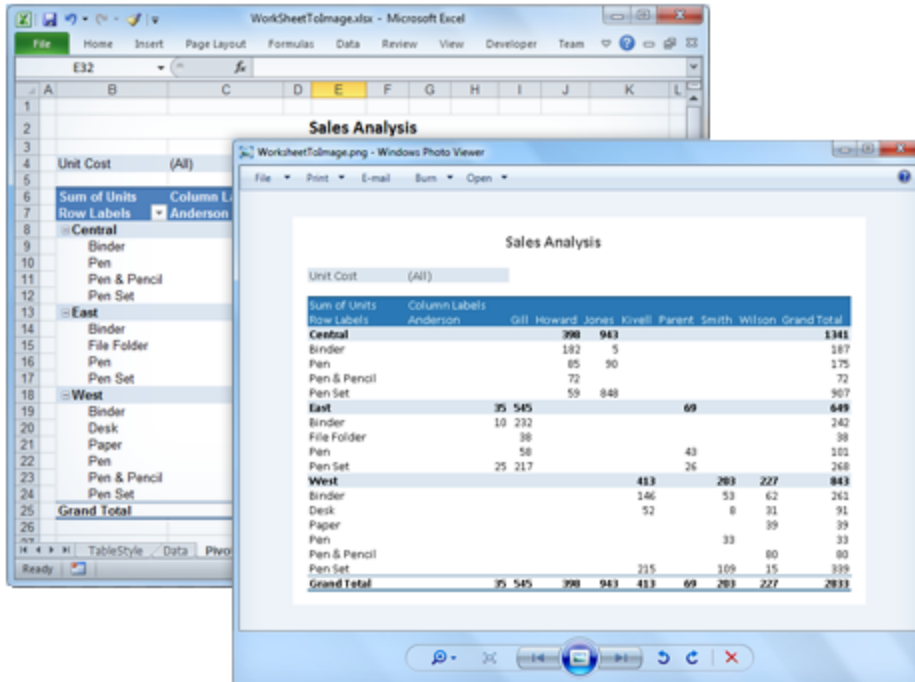
