Customize the data labels in maps control

Description:

As of now, data labels cannot be customized, so we have provided support to customize them in maps. You can use the **fontFamily**, **fontStyle**, **size**, **fontWeight**, **color**, and **opacity** properties to customize data labels.

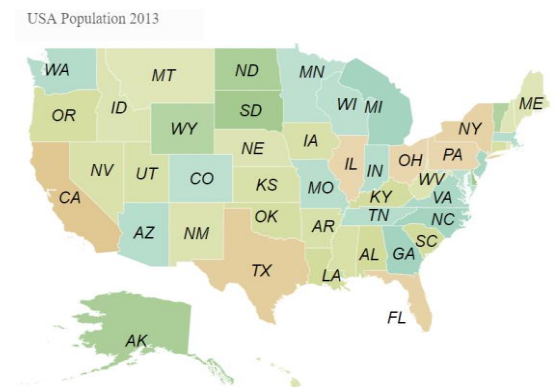


Fig 1: Label customization in maps.

Range Navigator

Support to include or exclude the first day of the next month in the selected data in range navigator control

Description

As of now, while selecting a month in Range Navigator, the days between January 1 and February 1 are selected. We could not ignore the February 1 data. So we have provided support to do this. Set the **allowNextValue** property as **false** and the days from January 1 to January 31 will be selected. By default, it is set as true.

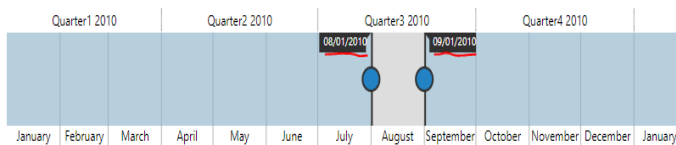


Fig 1: Range Navigator with labels allowNextValue as true.

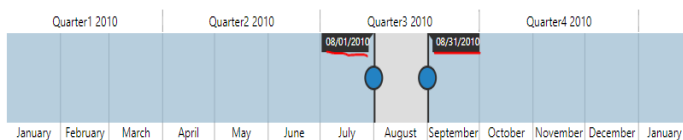


Fig 2: Range Navigator with labels allowNextValue as false.

Support to hide the intersecting labels in Range Navigator control

Description

The labels are displayed corresponding with the data value, both on the higher and lower levels of the Range Navigator. But right now, we cannot hide the labels when they intersect. So we have provided support to do this. The labels can be hidden by setting the **labelIntersectAction** property to **hide** in **labelSettings**. By default, it is set to **none**.

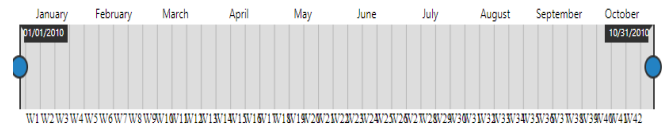


Fig 1: Range Navigator with labels and labelIntersectAction as none.

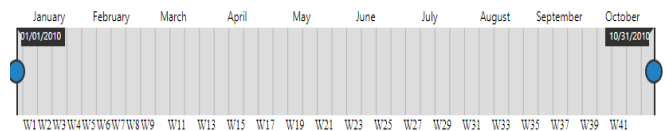


Fig 2: Range Navigator with labels and labelIntersectAction as hide.



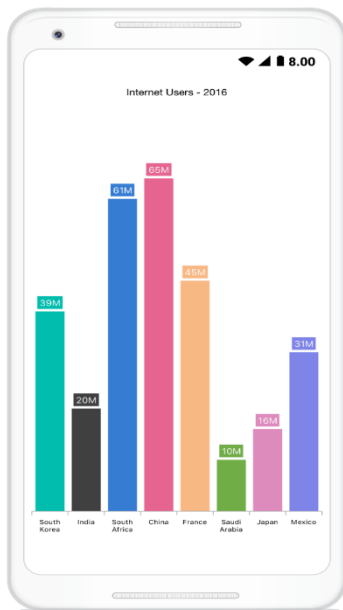

This feature wraps the words in axis labels into multiple lines when any label exceeds the expected maximum size.

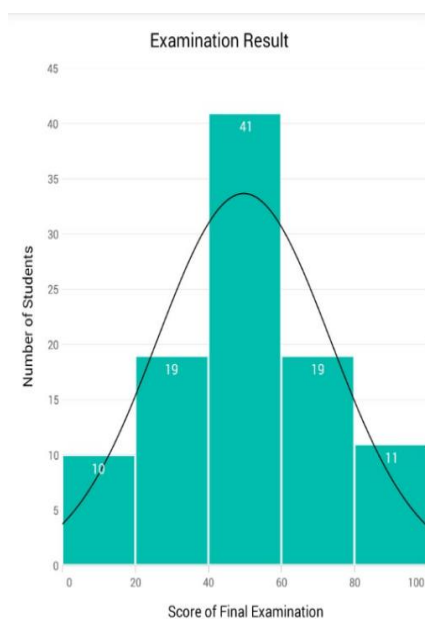

We have provided Histogram chart support. Histogram charts provide a visual display of a large amount of data that is difficult to understand in a tabular or data grid form.



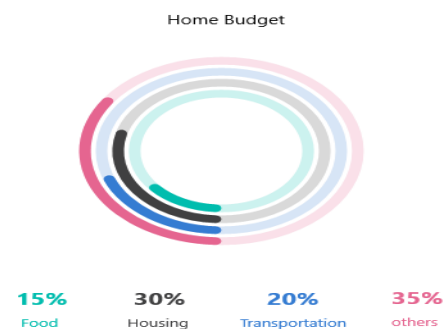

Stacked doughnut

Stacked doughnut support has been provided to visualize the chart in a set of individual concentric circles.

A stacked doughnut chart provides a versatile view of data (segments are placed individually) in accordance with the 100 percentage (or the maximum value set), whereas the regular doughnut chart renders the segments' size in accordance with the total value, which makes the view a little veiled.

This can be used in statistical applications like budget planning, health monitoring, and progress monitoring, etc., in which the data must be versatile in the eye of the user.

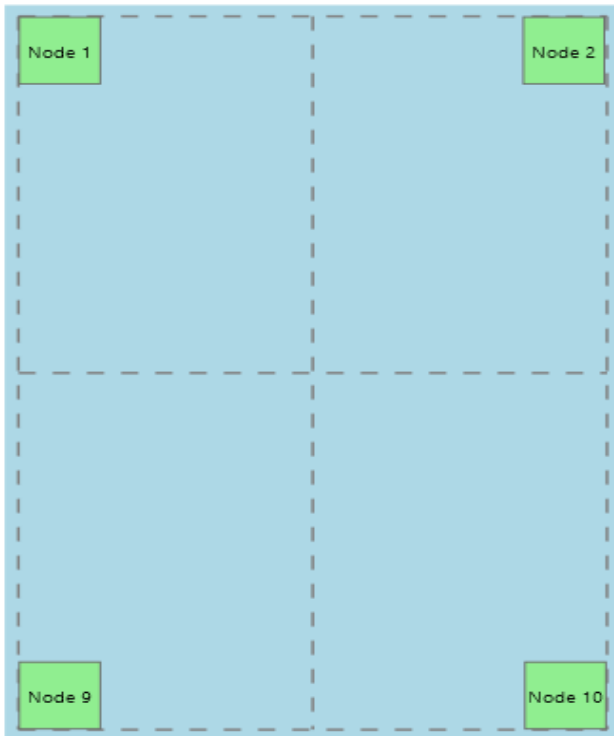
Scaling support for printing

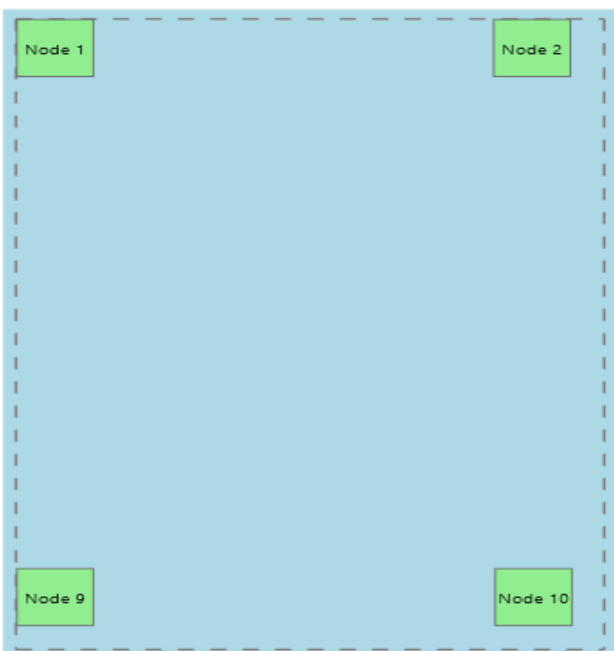

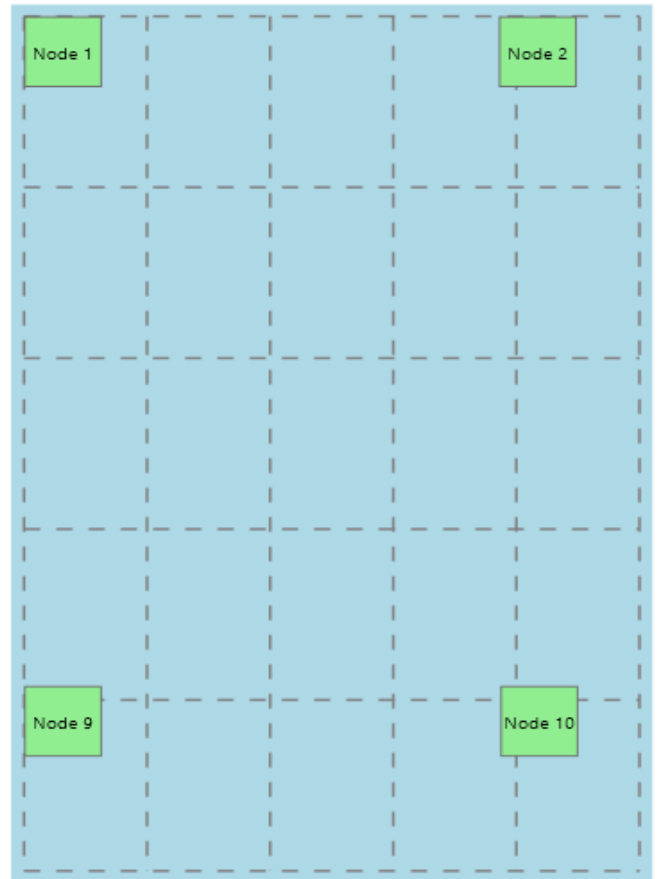
